The following were discussed:

1. Gayathri Tillekeratne gave a summary of the financials of the dashboard report that shows the income looks promising.
2. Bill Braband updated the CT on the John Fringer incident. We filed a claim based on attorney advice, and Church Mutual will handle things from here and inform us if anything else is needed from us.
3. Bill and Gayathri inquired on the detriments of having non-members work on the UUCF grounds and should this be allowed in the future. Bill Braband is to contact Rev. Richard Nugent at the Unitarian Universalist Association for advice.
4. The Siena School inquired about replacing a piece of slightly damaged playground equipment with tetherball. The CT voted no but gave the school the option of proposing a different piece of equipment and resubmitting a request to the CT and RE director for approval.
5. Rev. David Miller talked about the innovation fund and how to open up to the congregation for ideas to further the spirit of the fund. The gift letter states we need a three-person management team to oversee proposals and the project. Candidates were suggested, and results will be on future agendas.
6. Changing the "Closed because of COVID-19" signs throughout the campus to read we are open for in-person multi-platform service by appointment only Sundays at 10:30 a.m.
7. The CT retreat is scheduled for Nov. 6, 2021.
