1. The top pyramid represents knowledge and wisdom.

3. Third level is St. Andrew's Cross symbolizing one's Faith.
4. Bottom level is the earth with water running through it --the physical foundation to experience the previous three.

Robert Parker rated this wine 91 to 93 points and described it as the finest wine this property has produced since their great 1949. This is a spectacularly rich, powerful, authoritative example of the vintage that can compete with and even surpass many of the most famous names. Layer upon layer of concentrated, sweet, expansive, blackcurrant fruit is wrapped in a frame of toasty new oak and decent acidity. An awesome wine!

I had two bottles of this wine left from the case I bought on futures in 1990, so I drank one to see how it was holding up, and I'm offering the other. The bottle I opened was fully mature, but still close to peak. I could smell and taste the blackcurrant fruit, but the toasty new oak has developed into leather and cedar.

I couldn't find another bottle of 1989 Chateau Chasse-Spleen available for sale or auction in the United States, but the Newfoundland Labrador Liquor Corporation said they had it in stock. Unless you want to drive to Nova Scotia and take the ferry to Newfoundland, tonight may be your only chance to score a bottle of this awesome wine.
